WEATHER ADVICE:

SRI LANKA TRAVEL TIPS:

- Most visitors need an ETA visa (apply online before arrival).
- Drink bottled or filtered water to stay safe.
- Avoid street food vendors where possible, and always check with your guide to ensure any restaurants are hygiene safe.
- If you are visiting temples, it is customary and respectful to dress appropriately — covering shoulders and knees.
- Carry some Sri Lankan rupees in cash, as many smaller shops and rural areas do not accept cards. USD can be exchanged easily in most towns and at the airport.



WHAT TO PACK:

Light, breathable clothing, modest wear for visiting temples, sunscreen, insect repellent, a reusable water bottle, and sturdy shoes for hiking or climbing.
